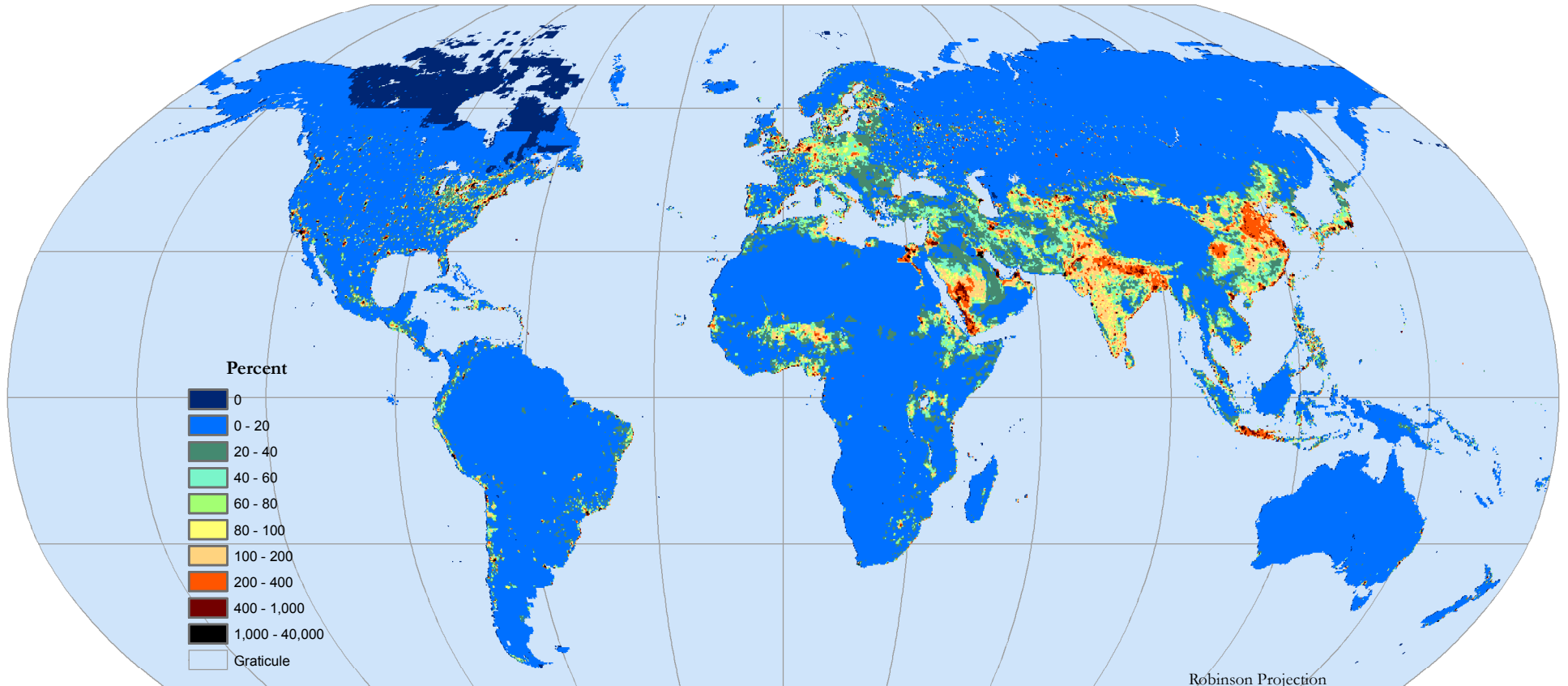


Human Appropriation of Net Primary Productivity (HANPP) as a Percentage of Local Net Primary Productivity
